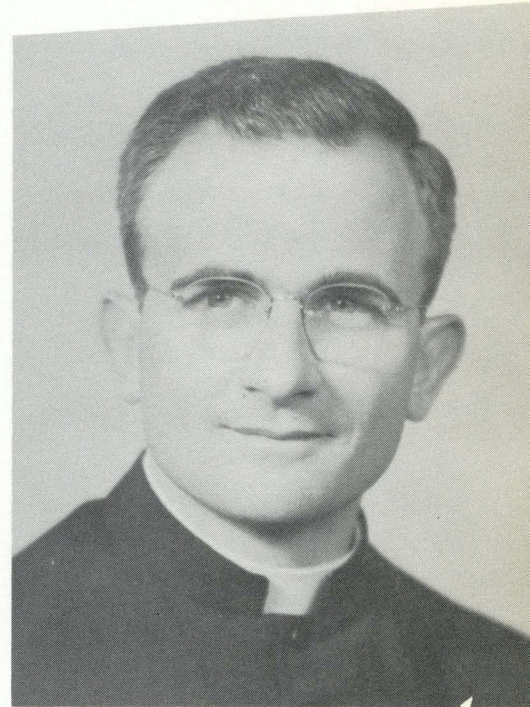
Dear Graduates,
