



Profile

Heeding a call of a priestly vocation, Anthony entered the Seminary in Vich, and on June 13th, 1835, was raised to the Holy Priesthood. He founded the Claretian Congregation on July 16, 1849. He was beatified on February 25th, 1934, by Pope Pius XI, who said, "Blessed Claret was indeed a great figure, a tireless apostle, moreover, a great organizer and a great precursor of Catholic Action." Blessed Claret was solemnly raised to the altars of the Catholic Church and proclaimed Saint by Pope Pius XII on the 7th of May, 1950.



Father Schweiger was reelected Superior General for a second term on May 10, 1951.








You shall attain your goal if you have a spirit of sacrifice and a true filial confidence in our Blessed Mother.




REV. JAMES GRIFFIN, C.M.F.







REV. LOUIS OLIVARES, C.M.F.




REV. FERMIN URRUTIA, C.M.F.


REV. JOSEPH RESENDEZ, C.M.F.
